1 External funding opportunities

2 Internal funding opportunities

Provide various internal grants that are international, interdisciplinary or cross the boundaries beyond academia for researchers at various career stages.

3 Post-funding support for management

Support with post-funding phases from the launch, operation, to compilation of research results for large-scale projects.

4 Internationalization of research

Provide comprehensive support including from finding a right partner to grant acquisition to promote international joint research projects while leveraging overseas Kyoto University Centers.

5 Support options for international faculty members

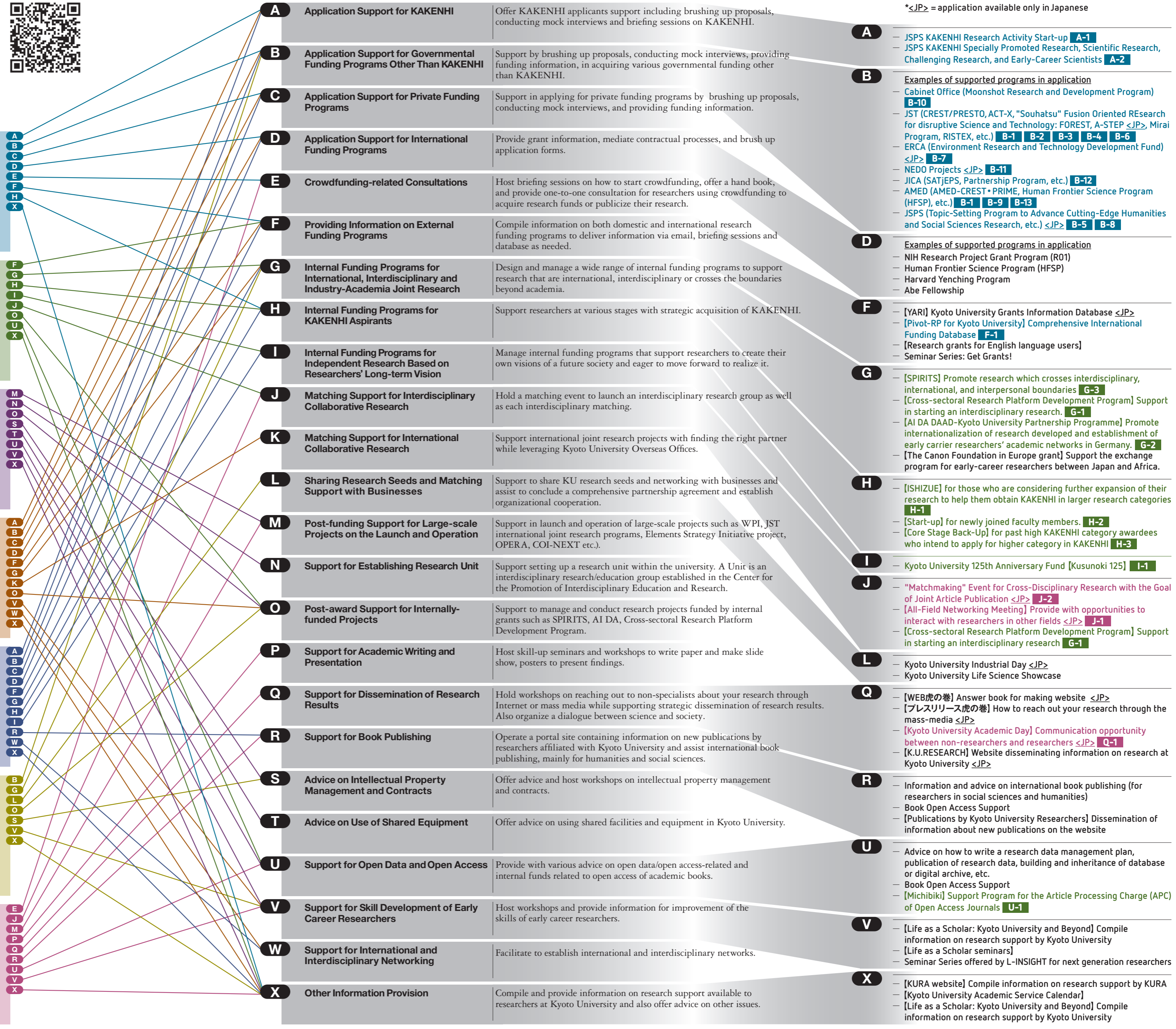
Create an environment where all researchers can focus on research by providing support for language barriers and networking opportunities for international faculty members.

6 Translation of research into practice

Support for matching and research collaboration with companies and other external institutions as well as translating research results for societal benefits.

Offer advice on open data and crowdfunding for research projects as well as PR strategies and book publishing.
